Congregational Meeting minutes  
July 19, 2009

Meeting called to order by Moderator - Micheal Hall at 11:55 am.

Roll Call of membership was not called due to the Congregational Vote on July 12, 2009. All individuals attending the Congregational meeting of Wedgewood Baptist Church have the right to vote on the affairs of the church.

Mission Offering - Motion to continue the mission offering as it has been in the past, motion from Mike Banister, second from Ed DePasquale, vote for the motion - ayes have it, against the motion - 2 votes.

Cleaning Service - Jerry Henderson stated that other bids for the cleaning service came in at a higher cost to the church. The current cleaning service was the result of our homeless mission outreach and we should stay with the current cleaning service. We have tenants in the building and should continue the current level of service.  
No motions from the floor to change the current situation.

Church Council - Motion not to have a Church Council, motion from Elaine Banister, second from Ed DePasquale, vote for the motion - ayes have it against the motion - no votes.

Chris' salary reduction - Motion not to ask for a deduction in Chris' salary, motion from Jose Garcia, second from Ed DePasquale, vote for the motion - ayes have it, against the motion - no votes.

New Business -

Jose requested that the church look again at the issue of needing a bathroom on the main level of the Fellowship Hall. Some funds have been provided, but the need is still there to renovate in the future. Jose's requested to speed up the process.

A statement from Cynthia Ricketson noting the voting during the congregational meeting did not change the current situation the church is currently in. The congregation did not address any financial changes or situations with the motions presented during the congregational meeting.

At the request of the Moderator, the budget shortage and the electrical cost was stated by Marge as being around \$ 3400.00. Current weekly contributions are now in the bulletins.

Jerry Henderson asked for any property suggestions including projects, money, etc. emailed to him so the Property Committee can address those needs of the church.
