

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
**OF**  
**WEDGEWOOD BAPTIST CHURCH**

I.

The name of the Corporation is: WEDGEWOOD BAPTIST CHURCH.

II.

The Corporation is a charitable or religious organization as defined by NCGS Section 55A-1-40(4).

III.

The street and mailing address and county of the initial registered office of the corporation is: 4800 Wedgewood Drive, Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina 28210, and the registered agent at such address is Warren L. Tadlock, who is a resident of North Carolina.

V.

The Corporation will not have members.

VI.

The government of this church shall be congregational in nature, and the final authority for the operation and management of the affairs of this congregation, in matters of faith and in temporal matters, shall be vested in the constituents of this corporation, which authority shall be exercised in the manner set forth in the constitution.

VII.

In the event of the dissolution of this corporation, to the extent allowed under applicable law, all the assets of the corporation shall be distributed to, or its assets shall be sold and the proceeds distributed to, another organization which has qualified for exemption from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. If for any reason, upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall fail to act in accordance with this Article within a reasonable time, the Senior Judge of Mecklenburg County shall make such distribution as is herein provided upon the application of one or more persons having a real interest in the Corporation or its assets.

VIII.

The street address and mailing address of the principal office of the Corporation is: 4800 Wedgewood Drive, Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina 28210.

IX.

These Articles will be effective upon filing.

X.

To the fullest extent permitted by the North Carolina Nonprofit Corporation Act as it exists or may hereafter be amended, no person who is serving or who has served as a constituent of this corporation (as that term is defined in the constitution) shall be personally liable to the corporation or any person or entity associated with the corporation for monetary damages for breach of duty as a constituent. No amendment or repeal of this article, nor the adoption of any provision to these Articles of Incorporation inconsistent with this article, shall eliminate or reduce the protection granted herein with respect to any matter that occurred prior to such amendment, repeal, or adoption.
